

2010 SZ Eastern Section Age Group Championships

Twelve GPAC qualifying swimmers made the trip to Charlotte, NC for the annual Sectional Age Group Championships Meet March 10-14th. The meet is the next step up in competition level from the Southeastern Championship Meet held in February at Nashville, TN. There were 93 teams represented with 934 athletes competing. GPAC swimmers accumulated 18 top 16 place finishes with 21 lifetime best swims. Leading the way was Caroline Page with 6 finals swims scoring 26 points. Caroline also won the 100 free with a team record time of 52.36. Caroline broke Beth Barrs record of 52.50 set back in March of 1986. Caroline also finished 4th in the 200 free 1:54.72, 9th 100 fly 58.23, 13th 50 free 24.87, 2nd 100 back 57.33, and 4th 200 back 2:05.52. Cody Keenan finished 16th in the 100 fly 56.03, and 15th in the 200 back 2:01.79. Anna Lundgren finished 11th in the 100 breast 1:22.55, 9th 100 IM 1:11.95, 12th 100 fly 1:11.35, 7th 100 free 1:02.14, 12th 50 free 28.75, and 9th 50 breast 37.66 earning 2 points. Laurel Rush finished 15th in the 1000 free 11:28.06, 13th 500 free 5:31.09, and 6th in the 1650 free 18:52.43 earning 3 points. Jack Tona finished 12th in the 200 fly with a time of 2:02.84. Victoria Bindi had a standout swim in the 100 free 58.13. Brooke Ferrara had a best time in the 200 back of 2:21.65. Logan Gurtowsky had a strong swim in the 100 free of 52.14. Lexi McNamara had a best time swim in the 100 free 58.89. Grace Menzies had a best time swim in the 100 breast 1:27.03. Garret Neel finished strong in the 100 back 1:19.30. Ian Price had a good swim in the 100 back 1:11.24. Our 11-12 girls 200 free relay finished strong in 8th place 1:47.29 earning 2 points. Brooke Ferrara led off in 27.02, Laurel Rush was second with 27.52, Lexi McNamara was third with 26.59, and Victoria Bindi was fourth with 26.16. Congratulations to all the GPAC swimmers who worked hard, swam great, and represented our team with pride. Results.
